Clinical Governance

Yorkshire Physiotherapy Network follows a framework through which we are accountable for continuously improving the quality of the service we provide. We aim to safeguard our high standards of care by ensuring clinical excellence throughout the practice.

Clinical governance includes clinical audit, risk management, health and safety, evidence-based practice, continuing professional development and reflective practice, all of which are ongoing and regularly reported on.

Clinical governance ensures:

- that processes which improve the quality of care are in place throughout the organisation
- the use of techniques to anticipate and prevent potential problems
- the use of techniques to monitor and improve the existing practice
- the ability to recognise and act upon poor performance, providing a framework which allows staff to learn from mistakes
- staff facilitate the implementation of good practice

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
